PURPOSE

Community Engagement Collective (CEC) is hosting the development of a coalition of community members and Black Indigenous and People of Color (BIPOC) Mental and Behavioral Health Providers to co-create the 2024 BIPOC Mental and Behavioral Health Provider Directory in Cincinnati.

2023 DIRECTORY IMPACT

CEC launched the 1st and 2nd directories to address the need to connect BIPOC community members with providers who self-identify as BIPOC. The 2023 directory is a free resource that has reached 347 community members, 40 Cincinnati neighborhoods, and 57 neighborhoods outside of Cincinnati. Of those that accessed the directory, 76% of community members self-identified as BIPOC, and 89% indicated they intended to share the resource with others.

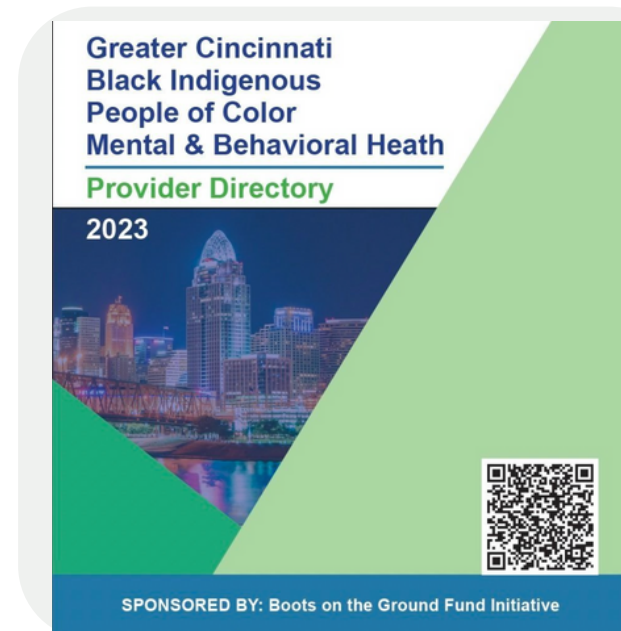
